Where to stay


We recommend you choose a hotel in the city center along the train stops (Oslo Central station - Nationaltheatret - Skøyen - Lysaker, see page 3). The local train will take you directly to the Research Council (train stop: Lysaker), where our meetings are. These central hotels are very popular, and reserving a block of rooms for our event at a special rate was not possible.

We advise you to book your room very soon! Please book your room online through <u>Booking.com</u>, <u>Hotels.com</u> or directly on the hotel's website.

How to get around

1) From Oslo Airport Gardermoen (OSL) to Oslo Central Station (Oslo S)

Option 1)

Use the <u>Airport Express train</u> (Flytoget) which leaves from Oslo Airport on Track 3. It takes ca. 30 min (with 0 or 1 stop).

Single ticket: NOK 240.-

Serves between 05:30 am - 00:50 am

Buy your ticket online or with the Flytoget-app on your mobile **Mobile app is strongly recommended!**



Option 2)

Use the Local Train, YV which leaves from Oslo Airport on Track 4. It takes 30 min (1 stop).

Single ticket: NOK 115.-

Serves between 05:15 am - 23:43 pm

Buy your ticket online or with the Vy-app on your mobile **Mobile app is strongly recommended!**






Figure 1: From Oslo Airport to Oslo city center (Central Station)







2) Meetings at the Research Council of Norway (RCN)

Address: Drammensveien 283, 0283 Oslo, Norway, meeting room ABEL

<u>From the Airport to RCN</u>: Take the local VY-train or the Airport Express train (Flytoget) from Oslo Airport to **Lysaker train stop**.




Figure 2. Train stops between Oslo Central station and Lysaker (Research Council)

From the city center to RCN, Take the local VY train from the Central station, Nationaltheatret, or Skøyen to the Lysaker train stop (Figure 2).

At **Lysaker,** leave the train station and cross the highway (Drammensveien) in the direction of the seaside (Figure 1). You will reach the Research Council after a 10 minute walk.

Figure 3. 10 minute walk from Lysaker train station to the Research Council








3) Hosted ExCo Dinner at Restaurant EIK (Wednesday, June 6, 2024 at 20:00)

Restaurant Eik is very close to the train- and subway stop "Nationaltheatret". It is a ca. 15 minute walk from the Central station (Oslo S).



4) Inaventa Solar, Jevnaker

Inaventa Solar invites you on Friday morning, June 7, 2024, for a technical tour of their production facility in Jevnaker, approx. 1 hour drive from Oslo. The tour and the lunch are free. You will see where Inaventa Solar's high performance polymer collectors are produced and the new extrusion line for the polymer absorbers. Inaventa's most recent innovation projects will be presented, which are supported by the Research Council, Horizon Europe and Enova.

The factory visit will be 1-2 hours, depending on the interest of the visitors.

Transportation will be planned based on who signs up.

Several options: Inaventa hosted lunch at the nearby Thorbjørnrud Hotel and transfer to Oslo Airport if needed (your flight should not depart before 3 pm on Friday). For those with more time, it is recommended to visit the nearby Kistefos Art Museum and sculpture park (one of my favorites). Transportation back to Oslo can be arranged for those who want to do sightseeing there.
